Students will be able to build a dynamic 'Future Skills' credit profile alongside studying A-Level qualifications, giving



Ignite exchange programme



HIF is home to the unique educational opportunity exclusively available to Year 9 students of Dulwich College International schools globally, offering these students an exciting and diverse curriculum of indoor and outdoor learning opportunities, all taking place in our breathtaking alpine environment.

Spending 12 weeks with HIF, participants cannot fail to be inspired and uplifted by the wildlife, mountains, forests, and rivers of the Lower Engadin valley.

Students are encouraged to develop their sense of adventure, independence, and discovery, through a rigorous core academic programme, a range of electives, and our 'Seasonal Sport Programme'.













Swiss Matura (Gymnasium)



The Swiss Matura is the official secondary school-leaving qualification in Switzerland. It is the main pathway to university education for students in the Swiss system. Rigorous and comprehensive, the Matura programme is approved by the federal and cantonal authorities, and gives students the unrestricted right to study at Swiss universities.

The bilingual Matura programme can be entered in grade 7 or 9 for students who meet the language requirements of fluent German, a second Swiss national language (Rhaeto-Romanic, French or Italian) and English. A selection of subjects is taught in English in order to obtain the bilingual Matura diploma; the Matura examinations follow the cantonal requirements.

In the Swiss Matura, teaching and learning are guided by the aims and objectives set out in the federal and cantonal curriculum frameworks, emphasising:

- A broad, rigorous general education
- Developing age-appropriate study skills and problem-solving strategies
- Self-directed, independent learning
- Project-based collaborative learning in teams
- Acquisition of in-depth, specialised knowledge in selected subjects
- Ability to evaluate arguments and evidence used in academic publications

The multi-faceted learning is enriched by excursions in Switzerland, academic clubs, participation in the student parliament, hikes in the Alps, music and art, as well as programmes to develop leadership skills and resilience.



















HIF **Sports Academy**

Academic Excellence + Sporting Excellence

The HIF Sports Academy is one of the oldest and most successful Swiss sports schools and is also a Swiss-Ski regional performance center (RLZ) for the disciplines of alpine skiing, cross-country skiing, biathlon and snowboard freestyle.

With professional and individual support, we develop the full potential of competitive athletes as well as those athletes who want to improve technique and performance.

This unique and successful model has already taken over 20 HIF athletes to the Youth Olympic Games (YOG) and/or the European Youth Olympic Festival (EYOF). Over two dozen HIF skiers, biathletes, cross-country skiers and snowboarders have made it to the Winter Olympics in the course of their careers.



The Role - Head of Gymnasium

HIF is seeking an exceptional candidate to lead the Gymnasium from January 2026 or sooner if available.

Reporting to the Head of Campus, the Head of Gymnasium will build on the achievements of an established team and seek to further develop the school's academic activities, outreach, and growing reputation.

Successful candidates will be proven and credible professionals, with the ability to lead highly capable teams. The Head of Gymnasium must possess the intercultural sensitivity and adaptability required to effectively navigate an international environment. They must be a team player, and the opportunities afforded to them of being part of a wider network of schools must genuinely excite them.

Fluency in German is essential.



The successful candidate will:

- Be a capable leader with relevant experience of development and execution of strategy.
- Have a demonstrated commitment to putting children first, motivated by the passion about delivering the best education.
- Possesses in-depth knowledge of the secondary school type Gymnasium (upper secondary school) as well as a teaching qualification recognised by the EDK (or equivalent)
- Has completed school leadership training or is willing to complete it alongside their work
- Understand how to use data to improve learning and teaching.
- Have proven experience of being able to collaboratively analyse problems, reach reasoned judgements and resolve issues.
- Be a highly committed team player with the drive, energy and passion to develop an expanding and forward-looking school and work within a network of schools.
- Have excellent communication and relationship building skills.
- Have high personal and professional expectations.
- Have demonstrable evidence of working effectively with integrity under pressure.
- Present as an effective and confident ambassador for HIF.
- Have a growth mindset.
- Show initiative and be able to pre-empt issues and challenges.



How to apply?

To apply, please submit a comprehensive CV and covering letter, which sets out your interest in the role and encapsulates the aspects of your experience relevant to the required criteria. Please include the names and addresses of three referees.

The closing date for applications is 29 August 2025.

Preliminary interviews will be conducted online, after which shortlisted candidates will be invited to HIF to take part in a sequence of in-person interviews with the leadership team. Interviews will take place on 18-19 September 2025 (subject to availability).

Referees will not be approached until the final stages and not without prior permission from candidates.
